Fabric is used for shrubs that are planted close together.

Tree fabric comes in rolls that we lay with a machine after the trees have been planted. We cannot lay the fabric the same day that we plant the trees, it must be put on at a later date.

4'x4' Mats are used for evergreens and tall trees that are spaced farther apart.
Staples are used to anchor the mats to the ground so that the wind doesn't blow them away ( $8-10$ per mat).

We do not install $4^{\prime} \times 4^{\prime}$ mats, that is your responsibility.
