Project Abstract	<p>Southwest Prairie Technical Service Area will be partnering to promote soil health adoption through peer-to-peer mentoring with local farmer mentors and agricultural professional consultants. Technical assistance without experienced mentorship has been a limiting factor in soil health adoption and we aim to bridge that gap by partnering with farmer mentors and agricultural professional consultants. These are experts in their fields with decades of experience that will provide the stability and knowledge new adopters need when implementing changes into their farming operations.</p> <p>Participating SWCDs will be encouraged to contract with farmer mentors and agricultural professional consultants on a yearly basis to allow for mentor and consultant quality and flexibility assurances. In the Southwest Prairie Technical Service Area participating counties include Cottonwood, Jackson, Lac Qui Parle, Lincoln, Lyon, Murray, Nobles, Redwood, Rock, and Yellow Medicine (Pipestone will be submitting a separate RFP).</p>
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Proposed Measurable Outcomes	Each of the participating SWCDs will have a workplan for their county and a tracking mechanism that will be completed quarterly. Tracking information will include things such as number of contacts, number of hours spent, special outreach/field days/workshops/etc. Locally, a list of landowner and producer contact information for each county will be created for continued outreach opportunities.
	Both the farmer mentors and agricultural professional consultants will assist local SWCDs with outreach and educational efforts including field days, workshops, and other activities. We anticipate exponentially increasing our producer contact numbers during these events. As producers work with mentors and consultants, we hope to see a ripple effect across the agricultural communities and professionals as those producers go back to their current agronomists to strategize soil health systems implementation in their operations.
	We estimate 830 contacts with landowners over 4 years. Among the SWPTSA partnering SWCDs, a total of 1,070 farmer mentor hrs/yr and 1,940 agricultural professional consultant hrs/yr. Additional outreach events will increase our number of contacts.

Description: Participating counties in the Southwest Prairie TSA include: Cottonwood, Jackson, Lac Qui Parle, Lincoln, Lyon, Murray, Nobles, Redwood, Rock, and Yellow Medicine (Pipestone will be submitting a separate RFP). These counties will be promoting peer to peer mentoring by local farmer experts in soil health practices and utilizing agricultural professional consultants with an emphasis in soil health to assist farmers transitioning to soil health systems.

The Southwest Prairie TSA will work with approximately 11 farmer mentors and 8 ag professional consultants on an annual basis.

Farmer mentors - \$75.00/per hour 1st and 2nd years and \$80.00/per hour for the 3rd and 4th years. Total - \$678,875

Ag professional consultants - \$85.00/per hour 1st and 2nd years and \$90.00/per hour 3rd and 4th years. Total - \$331,625

Contracts will be developed on a local SWCD level with each of their mentors and consultants yearly.

We have attached each SWCDs local work plan for their specific office, with the majority of the deliverables similar for each entity.

- Provide advice to farmers new to soil health practices by walking their fields with them.
